Kitchen

- Declutter and organise cabinets and cupboards
- Empty and clean the fridge and freezer
- Get rid of old food before going Christmas shopping
- Deep clean the oven
- Wipe and shine up all appliances
- Dust shelves and open surfaces
- Wash the holiday serving dishes
- Polish the silverware
- Wash the floor



Living room

- Declutter old newspapers and magazines
- Deep clean furniture, carpets and blinds
- Wipe window frames and polish surfaces
- Dust light fixtures, picture frames and decorations
- Wash the windows (optional)

Bathroom

- Inspect for mould and kill any build-ups first
- Clean all tiles, work extra hard on the grout
- Wash the shower curtain (if it's washable)
- Scrub the sink, tub, toilet and shower
- De-clutter the medicine and other cabinets
- Polish tapware and the mirror
- Stash up extra toiletries for guests
- Wash the bathroom mat

Bedroom

- Wash blankets and decorative pillowcases
 - Expose pillows to fresh air and sun
 - Organise your wardrobe
 - Put aside clothes for donation
 - Declutter drawers and shelving
 - Vacuum the carpets
 - Wipe the surfaces clean
 - Polish the baseboards
